In the USA, students start their education in **kindergarten** (at age 5) and finish at the end of **twelfth** grade. After that, they **graduate** and begin **college** or start a **career**.

1. <b>elementary school</b>	- from kindergarten to fifth or sixth grade
2. middle school	- for students <b>from grade 6 to 8</b>
3. <b>high school</b>	- for students from grade 9 to 12
high school students are called /referred to as	- freshmen - sophomores - <b>juniors</b> - <b>seniors</b>
some schools	- from kindergarten to grade <b>eight</b>
schedules	- morning <b>break</b> - <b>lunch break</b> - afternoon break for younger students: <b>recess</b>
changes for students:	- younger students: the <b>same</b> teacher <b>all day</b> - older students change <b>classes</b> and have <b>different</b> teachers
