Scotland's location	●	6	● It's the capital of Scotland.

the Highlands	●	8	● Only very few people live here. It's the perfect place to see all the countryside and wildlife.
the Northern lights	●	3	● It was once a volcano and you have a beautiful view over Edinburgh from here.
Edinburgh	●	2	● It's in the north of the UK.
Loch Ness	●	1	● It's a big castle on top of a hill in the capital of Scotland.

Arthur's seat	●	7	● They mainly liv in the Lowlands
Kilts	●	10	● They are a special musical instrument. The player blows air into the bag and then makes music with the pipes.
Bagpipes	●	9	● They are traditional skirts for men worn on special events, such as weddings.
